SCHOOL DINNERS FOR TERM 3 TERM 4 2009

The cost of hot two-course lunch will remain at **£1.55** per day, **£7.75** per week for the next two terms and the current 3 week menu continues until Easter.

If you wish to pay for Terms 3 and/or 4 in advance the amounts are as follows:

TERM 3 – Tuesday, 6th January, 2009 – Friday, 13th February, 2009 = 29 days @
£1.55 per day = **£44.95**

TERM 4 – Monday, 23rd February, 2009 – Friday, 3rd April, 2009 = 30 days @ £1.55 per day = **£46.50**

Total payable for Term 3 and 4 together = 59 days @ £1.55 = **£91.45**

Cheques should be made payable to South Gloucestershire Council and any refunds due to absence will be returned to you at the end of term.
