SCHOOL DINNERS FOR TERM ONE AND TERM TWO 2009/10

The cost of hot two-course lunch will increase to **£1.60** per day, **£8.00** per week from September, 2009. The kitchen will continue to use the current menu, if you require another copy please enquire at the school office.

**IF YOU WISH TO PAY FOR TERMS ONE AND/OR TWO IN ADVANCE THE AMOUNTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

TERM ONE – Monday, 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2009 – Friday, 23<sup>rd</sup> October, 2009 = 35 days @ £1.60 per day = **£56.00**

(less 3 days, £4.80, for those in Year 6 going to Hooke Court)

TERM TWO – Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2009 – Friday, 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2009 = 35 days @ £1.60 per day = **£54.40**

TOTAL FOR TERM ONE AND TERM TWO = 70 days @ £1.60 = **£110.40.**

Please send the money in an envelope clearly marked with **NAME OF CHILD/CHILDREN, CLASS AND DAYS STAYING.**
