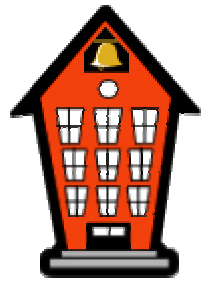




Handy Hints for Year 6 Revision – How can you help?



- Lots of encouragement and confidence building.
- Regular interest in what they have been learning about at school.
- Keep up the practice of times tables, little and often.
- Have a go at random spellings, not too hard!
- Hearing your child read. Concentrate on correcting any misread words and the expression used in their voice. Help them to make the connection between punctuation and expression.
