KPI: To Write with purpose:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Discuss examples of writing in order to plan and rehearse their own writing. ○ Write for an increasing range of purposes, using the features of narrative, poetry and the six main non-fiction text types securely. ○ Use authorial techniques to create characters, settings and plots. ○ Viewpoint is clear (e.g. personal viewpoint, writing in role, conclusions in non-fiction) ○ Review and evaluate their own and others' writing to make improvements to the content, grammar, vocabulary in relation to Y4 expectations. ○ Edit and proof-read their writing to correct spelling and punctuation errors. 	KPI: To apply grammar and punctuate accurately	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Use fronted adverbials for effect, followed by a comma. ○ Use expanded noun phrases to add detail. ○ Use main and subordinate clauses and move their position in sentences. ○ Extend the range of complex sentences by using a wider range of connectives (e.g. when, if, because, although, whilst, as). ○ Use a mixture of simple, compound and complex sentences. ○ Use inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate direct speech. ○ Use apostrophes to indicate plural possession.
