## The Role

### Complex Medical Needs

- ◆ To liaise with parents, pupil, teacher, support staff and medical health professionals to ensure that short term or long term complex medical needs are met throughout the school day.
- ◆ To offer support to parents and/or families to enable a child to progress to being independent with their medical requirements and signposting to outside agencies where applicable.
- ◆ Support where families are facing health/medical challenges.
- ◆ To ensure all staff who need to be aware of medical needs have the training to do so.
