Netball with a focus on the different throws as along with the rules.

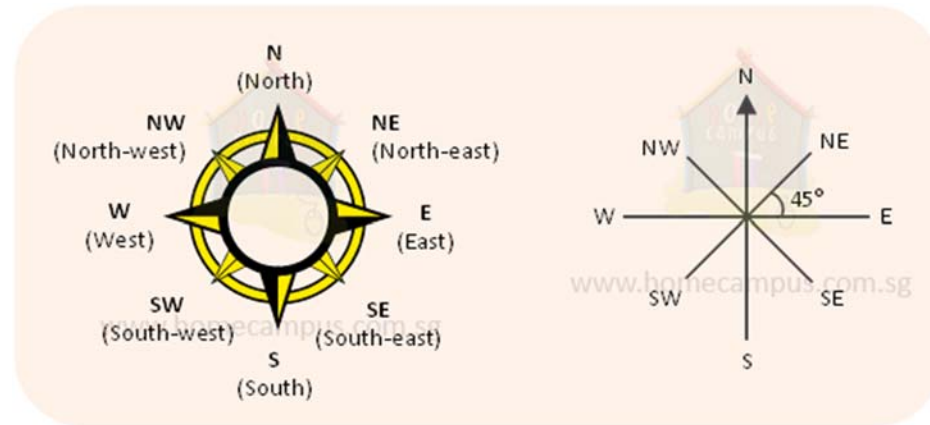
