Using our learning gained from our Aquarium visit, we will further develop our understanding on interdependence, adaptation and evolution. We will also be looking at the classification of living things.

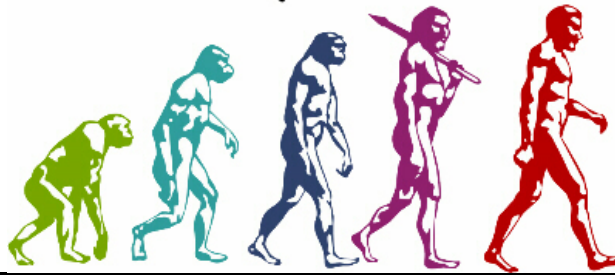
Mathematics
