## Key facts to be learnt at home

- The Nile provided the ancient Egyptians with fertile land which helped them to grow their crops and raise their animals.
- Egypt is mainly made up of hot deserts and receives little rainfall. Without the River Nile, the area would be entirely desert.
- Hieroglyphs are a language of symbols. There are over 700 hieroglyph signs but only for consonants. There were no vowel signs.
- Ancient Egyptians believed that if they mummified a pharaoh's body and protected it in a pyramid it would live forever in the after life.
- The Rosetta Stone was used to crack the code and understand hieroglyphics.
