

Physical Development

The children will explore basic movements such as running, jumping, hopping and skipping. They will have opportunities to practice throwing, catching and kicking. The children will then think about why it is important to stay healthy, and the effect that physical exercise has on their bodies.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be playing lots of party games with the children to encourage them to take turns and appreciate both winning and losing.

We will also continue to support the children to follow the rules of the classroom.

Communication and Language

The children will discuss special events that they may have celebrated, working on using past tense accurately. We will look at how different cultures celebrate events and encourage the children to start asking interesting how and why questions.

Understanding the World

We will look at how different cultures and religions celebrate special events and look at the similarities and differences between families, communities and traditions. The children will also explore the uses of basic technology in school and at home.

Expressive arts and design

The children will continue to use drawings and paintings to make representations of people and objects. We will encourage them to think carefully about their choice of colours. We will also begin to explore different types of musical instruments and the sounds they make.

Literacy

The children will continue to learn new sounds each week. We will practise blending and segmenting to read and write simple words. We will look at different purposes for writing and have a go at writing cards and invitations for our friends.

Mathematics

The children will work on accurately counting objects up to ten and then twenty. We will start to think about joining two groups of objects and working out how many there are altogether.
