English

This term we will be looking at stories from a range of cultures and comparing them to stories set in the UK. We will also write our own fact files on different animals! We will continue to think about spellings and spelling patterns including words that end in es or s.

Geography

Barnaby will be showing us some of the human and physical features of the UK. We will be looking at how the weather changes day by day and linking it to our ongoing work on seasons. We will create our own maps and use simple symbols in a key.

Mathematics

This term we will be continuing to learn how to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will learn how to multiply and divide. We will think about our measuring skills of height, weight and capacity and think about how we can use these to solve problems. We will also revisit our addition and subtraction skills and use these to solve problems too!
