

Science

We will be investigating forces by completing experiments on air resistance, water resistance and friction. We will also look at how some mechanisms such as levers and pulleys effect forces.

Geography

We will be looking at geographical similarities and differences of Bristol and Brazil. We will be looking at locations of cities using longitude, latitude and compass points. We will recap the water cycle and look at rivers.

Mathematics
