

## Physical Development

We will be using the large apparatus to develop good control and coordination. We will also be using music from different cultures and exploring ways to express ourselves, thoughts and ideas through dance and movement.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be encouraging children to confidently try new activities and say why they like some activities more than others. The children will be developing skills to choose their own resources to support their learning.

## Communication and Language

We will be using past, present and future tenses correctly by talking about our own experiences and wishes. We will also be working on speaking clearly to explain our ideas, by connecting sentences together in the correct order.

## Understanding the world

We will be learning about and exploring different places around the world. We will be comparing our own country to others, noticing similarities and differences. The children will explore how information can be retrieved from computers and how technology is used around the world to help us communicate.
