Music

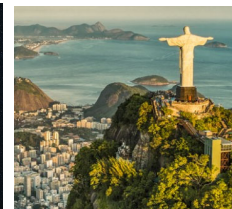
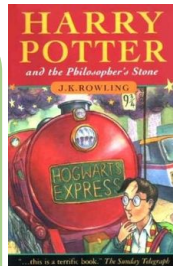
We will be continuing looking at Samba Music with Mrs Cardy. The children will be exploring and creating their own samba musical creations.
