

Physical Development

We will think about how to be strong super heroes who need to practise moving, climbing and traveling using basic gym apparatus. **We will apply our number and measures learning, for example by counting how many hops we can do in one minute or finding out who can do the longest superhero jump.**

The children will continue to practise their pencil control and start to write their names using the correct letter formations.

Understanding the World

We will think about the roles of people in our community who can help us. We will learn about when we might need the police, fire fighters or paramedics to come and help us. We will all try to learn the number on the front of our house and our road name in case we get lost and need to ask for help.

Literacy

The children will continue to learn new sounds each week. We will keep practicing our blending and segmenting of sounds to read and write simple words. We will continue to read and focus on a different story book linked to our topic each week. We will explore a range of different purposes for writing and mark making. We will also begin to use the sounds we know to start writing simple captions or labels.

Communication and Language

There will be lots of opportunities to role play being Superheroes and heroes of our community such as fire fighters, police officers and paramedics. On Fabulous Fridays we will continue to develop our speaking, listening and questioning skills.

In the run-up to Christmas, we will ask the children to think back and describe special celebrations or events that they have celebrated with their families.

We will also look at photos of different teachers' and parents celebrating Christmas and birthdays from when they were young and think about how technology was used to make memories before Ipads and smart phones!

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will continue to support the children to follow the rules and routines of the classroom. We will teach and model simple conflict resolution skills that will help them to independently solve any disagreements with their friends.

The children will think about and discuss their own super powers that make each of them special.

Expressive arts and design

The children will continue to use drawings and paintings to make representations of people and objects. We will encourage them to think carefully about their choice of colours. **They will copy and create their own patterns for craft activities linked to our topic and to Christmas.** We will also begin to explore different types of musical instruments and the sounds they make.
